Trading of the rights entitlements:

Prior to the Issue Opening Date, our Company will obtain the approval from the NSE for trading of Rights Entitlements. Investors shall be able to trade their Rights Entitlements either through On Market Renunciation or through Off Market Renunciation. The trades through On Market Renunciation and Off Market Renunciation will be settled by transferring the Rights Entitlements through the depository mechanism. #### **Renunciation of rights entitlements:**

# FRACTIONAL ENTITLEMENT:

The Right Shares are being offered on a rights basis to existing Eligible Shareholders in the ratio of 7 (Seven) Right Shares for every 10 (Ten) Equity Shares held as on the Record Date. As per SEBI Rights Issue Circulars, the fractional entitlements are to be ignored.
